

NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION

MOORE PARK RAVINE BEHIND 193 AND 195 HUDSON DRIVE SLOPE STABILIZATION PROJECT, IN THE CITY OF TORONTO

Toronto and Region Conservation Authority (TRCA) is preparing to implement erosion control and slope stabilization works to address valley slope erosion south of Mud Creek, behind two residential properties on Hudson Drive, in the City of Toronto. The work area includes the valley slope south of Mud Creek where ongoing slope instability has created a risk to existing structures. No work is planned in Mud Creek as part of the Project.

Scope of work will include select tree and vegetation removals and installation of an engineered slope stabilization solution, followed by comprehensive restoration including native shrub and tree plantings.

Construction Related Information:



Post-construction restoration (e.g. tree and shrub plantings) is planned for Fall 2023, depending on weather conditions.



Monday—Friday, 7:00 AM to 5:00 PM.



For your safety, please respect all posted construction signage & stay clear of the work area, staging/stockpiling area, & all equipment.



There may be temporary construction related dust & noise during working hours.



Deliveries via Hudson Drive will occur intermittently during working hours. Please obey all signage and directions from site personnel.
